- Create roles for parents to volunteer and engage in their child's educational development.
- Plan community outreach events including career & resource fairs, Eastie Serves, & the Maverick Community Connector

- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong project management and organization tools
- Achieve goals within a team and independently
- Serve Full-time
