SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Youth Leadership Coordinator positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2020 and June 2021. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc. The YLC will serve as leaders to a youth council, increase the capacity of host sites to implement social capital building, youth engagement and community service-learning as strategies to achieve high educational outcomes.

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Work with high school juniors and seniors in small groups and in one-on-one bi-weekly sessions to develop and track progress on each student's individual academic and career success plan.
- Oversee & coordinate information sessions with partners (i.e. Bottom Line, uAspire, Year Up and more) to ensure that students have as many resources as possible to assist them with career and college exploration and selection; Organize and/or facilitate skills-based professional development workshops.
- Leverage each student's mentors and BUILD volunteers to make sure every student receives the one-on-one guidance, support and accountability they need to succeed.
- Assist & support the development of the BUILD Boston Alumni Network; Participate in the evaluation & development of BUILD's Social Entrepreneurship Program

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
