- Planning & Implementation of YMCA Teen Programs including curriculum development, volunteer support, and data collection
- Tracking attendance and ensuring teen participants receive a quality experience which places them on a pathway to success through college and career readiness, leadership skills, and civic engagement.
- Being the main point of contact and directly supervising YMCA Teen Programs in coordination with the Regional Teen Director.
- Serving in-person for at least 80% of total hours (*first weeks of service will be mostly remote due to current number of MA COVID-19 cases*)

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
