- Identification and listing of community resources with specific relevance to the METCO Community, including design and creation of newsletters, resources database and website;
- Assisting & supporting METCO Students during the college application process through direct supports or using partners who provide higher education supports
- Assisting in the development of an after school program that includes academics and enrichment opportunities

- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
