SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Youth Leadership Coordinator positions for a 900-hour service commitment between February 2021 and July 2021. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc. The YLC will serve as leaders to a youth council, increase the capacity of host sites to implement social capital building, youth engagement and community service-learning as strategies to achieve high educational outcomes.

- Recruit and coordinate students for the school's Yearbook Club, and assist students in the design and publishing of the 2020-2021 yearbook.
- Coordinate the 2020-2021 Junior/Senior Prom Committee which consists of recruiting students for the committee, assisting with logistics & planning, and planning for a potentially virtual event.
- Develop, recruit, and run an After-School Leadership Club -- tasks will include creating the club's mission & objectives, creating tools to measure outcomes & impact, and finding service projects for student participants.
