

SCI AmeriCorps — 2021-2022 Host Site RFP

Since 2002, the mission of Social Capital Inc. (SCI) has been to strengthen communities by connecting diverse individuals and organizations through civic engagement initiatives. We envision a nation where individuals are strongly connected to their neighbors and play an active role in shaping the destiny of their communities by building social capital, resulting in communities that are safer, healthier and more vital.

The SCI AmeriCorps program enables community organizations to connect youth with people, experiences and resources they need to succeed. We support youth achievement through volunteer outreach and capacity building that helps provide leadership training and community service opportunities at our host site partner organizations. Our SCI AmeriCorps members build social capital by connecting community members to the information they need and fostering civic engagement among youth and adults.

Your Organization can host a SCI AmeriCorps Member serving in one of two positions:

- **Volunteer Outreach Coordinator (VOC)**: supporting volunteer engagement efforts for youth-focused programming through community events, relationship building, online marketing, program management, and database management.
- **Youth Leadership Coordinator (YLC)**: supporting youth engagement efforts through program management, direct mentorship, community service-learning activities, educational resources, and leadership opportunities.
- SCI AmeriCorps is also open to organizations who want to address ongoing needs in their community related to COVID-19 that fall within the focus of youth support, development and/or success.

HOST SITE BENEFITS

- SCI AmeriCorps Member who is committed to serve 1700 hours, full-time, between September 2021 and June 2022.
- A 2-step interview process: SCI manages the recruitment and conducts a first interview, before recommending a second interview for the host site partner to evaluate the applicant.
- SCI manages all HR administrative duties including member stipend, background checks, health care benefits, worker's compensation, and federal grant compliance.
- SCI provides members with training and professional development opportunities, as well as ongoing member support and performance monitoring.
