



SCI AmeriCorps – Volunteer Outreach Coordinator

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Volunteer Outreach Coordinator (VOC) positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2021 and June 2022. The VOC will develop and implement practices for effective volunteer engagement at their host sites by focusing on SCI's core values of relationship development and nurturing local social networks.

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Develop and implement best practices for effective volunteer engagement opportunities to help support the college to career pipeline, employer engagement, alumni engagement, and key programmatic initiatives related to workforce/career development for Bottom Line students and recent Bottom Line graduates.
- Oversee the Go Far Volunteer recruitment and matching process which matches local professionals with Bottom Line students to provide industry insight and coaching on a range of career-related items, with an ambitious goal of overseeing and managing 100 student-to-volunteer connections during the academic year.
- Collaborate closely with the development team to organize and streamline communication with our volunteers and individuals interested in engaging/supporting our students.

REQUIREMENTS

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- *Availability to serve in-person for on-site programming.*
