



## SCI AmeriCorps – Youth Leadership Coordinator

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

**SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Youth Leadership Coordinator positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2020 and June 2021. The YLC will increase the capacity of host sites to implement social capital building, youth engagement and community service-learning as strategies to achieve high educational outcomes.**

### **HOST SITE OPPORTUNITY – Girls Inc. of Lynn (Lynn, MA)**

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Serve as Advisor to Part of the Solution Peer Leader group whose focus is primarily on substance abuse education and prevention and youth leadership in the city of Lynn, working with six youth to develop leadership skills through policy advocacy, event coordination, community service learning projects, public-speaking, and educational outreach opportunities for youth and parents.
- Support the implementation of Girls Inc. Friendly PEERSuasion curriculum within the Girls Inc. building and the LifeSkills curriculum in the Lynn community.
- Write monthly reports on youth council activities, coordinate and implement evaluation tools of activities and events, and maintain a database of members, attendance, and event participation.
- Collaborate with other Teen Program advisors to create monthly peer leading trainings for 24 teen girls.
- Assist the Community Coordinator of Substance Abuse Prevention Program in coordinating substance abuse prevention activities at Girls Inc. of Lynn and within the community.

### **REQUIREMENTS**

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- *Availability to serve in-person for on-site programming. Access to a car required.*
