



SCI AmeriCorps – Youth Leadership Coordinator

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Youth Leadership Coordinator positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2020 and June 2021. The YLC will increase the capacity of host sites to implement social capital building, youth engagement and community service-learning as strategies to achieve high educational outcomes.

HOST SITE OPPORTUNITY – New Mission High School (Boston, MA)

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Coordinate the development and launch of a Student Council at New Mission High School. The NM Student Council will be involved in school-based service learning and community engagement projects, the goals of which include:
 - Leadership skill development for participating students
 - School-based community projects
 - Engagement with the New Mission school community & surrounding Hyde Park neighborhood
 - Connect participating students with additional resources & opportunities.
- Assist with and support communications and messaging to school students & families. Member will also support alumni outreach and social media communications.

REQUIREMENTS

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- *Availability to serve in-person for on-site programming. Access to a car required.*

- Receive a Taxable Stipend up to \$15,000/year, paid bi-weekly
- Earn a Federal Education Award worth \$6000+ on successful completion of service
- Professional Development Trainings
- Eligible for Free Health Care at a no cost premium
- Can receive Student Loan Forbearance during active service
