



SCI AmeriCorps – Volunteer Outreach Coordinator

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Volunteer Outreach Coordinator (VOC) positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2021 and June 2022. The VOC will develop and implement practices for effective volunteer engagement at their host sites by focusing on SCI's core values of relationship development and nurturing local social networks.

HOST SITE OPPORTUNITY – UMASS Dartmouth Leduc Center (Dartmouth, MA)

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Coordinate closely with our 40+ SouthCoast Serves collaborative of community-based organizations to engage marginalized and disadvantaged youth by providing resources and service-learning opportunities that increase their social capital.
- Coordinate & Manage the 9/11 Day of Service, where students from local schools participate in leadership training and then lead teams of volunteers at our service event at the YMCA Share the Harvest Farm in Dartmouth.
- Coordinate & Manage the MLK Day Youth Leadership Institute, providing students from local schools with the skills, knowledge, and abilities to develop and implement service projects in their respective schools.
- Create & Execute a plan to work with staff, partners and volunteers to implement SCI's WorldFest and Cultural Connections programs in a virtual or hybrid format. Explore new opportunities for initiatives to promote dialogue and action related to racial equity.

REQUIREMENTS

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- *Availability to serve in-person for on-site programming. Access to a car is required.*

BENEFITS

- Receive a Taxable Stipend up to \$15,000/year, paid bi-weekly
- Earn a Federal Education Award worth \$6000+ on successful completion of service
- Professional Development Trainings
- Eligible for Free Health Care at a no cost premium
- Can receive Student Loan Forbearance during active service
