- Create social media posts, project reports and other communications for internal and external distribution that document results and the impact of corporate volunteer projects.
- Research, curate and promote best practices in implementing volunteer programs (internally and across the sector) and prepare data driven recommendations to inform our work.

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
