

SCI AmeriCorps — **Youth Leadership Coordinator**

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Youth Leadership Coordinator (YLC) positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2020 and June 2021. The YLC will increase the capacity of host sites to implement social capital building, youth engagement and community service-learning as strategies to achieve high educational outcomes.

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Implement youth development activities offered at the Club that aim to empower youth to
 influence their community, sustain meaningful relationships with others, develop a positive
 self-image, participate in the democratic process and respect their own and others' cultural
 identities.
- Support program staff at the Club, create & run their own daily programming, and advise the Club's community service and leadership groups.
- Work with another SCI AmeriCorps member to engage youth in strengthening their social capital

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- Availability to serve in-person for some or all service activities.

- Earn a Federal Education Award worth \$6000+ on successful completion of service
- Professional Development Trainings
- Eligible for Free Health Care at a no cost premium
