

SCI AmeriCorps – Volunteer Outreach Coordinator

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Volunteer Outreach Coordinator (VOC) positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2021 and June 2022. The VOC will develop and implement practices for effective volunteer engagement at their host sites by focusing on SCI's core values of relationship development and nurturing local social networks.

The SCI AmeriCorps member will:

- Build bridges across Dorchester sub-communities through management of the MyDorchester Volunteer Program and mydorchester.org, presenting at civic association meetings, and organizing community events.
- Manage volunteer events like the Holiday Gift Giveaway and Boston Shines, as well as engage community members at the Dorchester Winter Farmers Market and Tax Clinics.
- Take advantage of new opportunities to engage students and leverage community volunteers through a growing relationship with Codman Academy.
- Engage additional community partners with a focus on education, including; Action for Boston Community Development (ABCD), Healthworks Community Fitness, TechBoston Academy, and The Daily Table.

REQUIREMENTS

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- Availability to serve in-person for some or all service activities.

- Receive a Taxable Stipend up to \$18,000/year, paid bi-weekly
- Earn a Federal Education Award worth \$6000+ on successful completion of service
- Professional Development Trainings
- Eligible for Free Health Care at a no cost premium
