



SCI AmeriCorps – Volunteer Outreach Coordinator

The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement volunteer outreach and capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and service-learning opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps members have served at various host sites in Greater Boston, who are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc.

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for members to fill Volunteer Outreach Coordinator (VOC) positions for a 1700-hour service commitment between September 2021 and June 2022. The VOC will develop and implement practices for effective volunteer engagement at their host sites by focusing on SCI's core values of relationship development and nurturing local social networks.

Under the direction of the Deputy Director, the SCI AmeriCorps Member will:

- Support ongoing development and management of SCI's volunteer, donor, and grants database systems.
- Assist the planning and implementation of volunteer engagement campaigns and general communications: including management of the quarterly SCI e-newsletter, SCI social media accounts, and SCI website.

- Able to commit to Full-Time service in local communities with diverse residents
- Effective communication skills to conduct community outreach through marketing strategies and civic engagement
- Strong work ethic, collaboration, and time management skills
- *Availability to serve in-person for some or all service activities.*
