SCI Teen Vaccine Equity & Access Program

Volunteer Coach Opportunities

What is the Teen VEAP program?

- The SCI Teen VEAP (Vaccine Equity Access Project) is SCI's **effort to increase teen COVID-19 vaccination rates**, with a focus on populations that have been most hard hit by the pandemic and that have lower vaccination rates.
- The Teen VEAP includes direct **outreach** by SCI, and an opportunity for other youth groups to develop & pitch their own ideas for increasing teen vaccination. Successful groups can receive up to \$1,000 for their projects.
- The Teen VEAP program is a companion program to SCI's adult VEAP efforts, funded by the CDC.
- The Teen VEAP program is starting in Woburn, funded by CHNA 15, with plans to expand to other communities.

What is the role of the Teen VEAP Coaches?

- SCI is recruiting for **Volunteer Coaches** who will *provide guidance and mentoring to a team of teens that is developing a **vaccination promotion initiative**.*
- **Coaches** will volunteer for **4 weekly virtual coaching sessions**, at a mutually agreeable time, with support from SCI.
- Primary areas for coaching will include developing an effective messaging strategy, project planning and presentation/ public speaking skills.
- Coaches with a background in one or more of the following areas are encouraged to volunteer: *marketing, public health, project planning and public speaking.*
