The SCI AmeriCorps program supports youth success by connecting young people with the relationships, experiences, and resources they need to succeed. Members implement capacity building activities that increase volunteer participation, and provide leadership training and community service opportunities for youth. Since 2007, SCI AmeriCorps Members have served at various host sites in the Greater Boston area that are aligned with the mission of Social Capital Inc. (SCI).

SCI AmeriCorps is currently looking for candidates to fill positions for a 900-hour service term (approximately 40 hours/week) from late January 2024 through June 2024.

- Support 6th-12th grade youth in a group setting, with the specific topics for teens on wellness and job skills and specific STEM related topics for middle school
- Assist in daily implementation and organization of activities, lesson plans, and providing academic support for youth
- Support with youth curriculum refinement and curriculum evaluation implementation
- Manage and promote community service-learning and volunteer opportunities for youth in grades 6-12
- Collaborate with EBSOC staff to develop and execute a volunteer engagement plan that will support teen programming

SCI AmeriCorps Member - Essential Requirements

- Commit to full term-of-service in local communities with diverse residents
- Serve in-person for some or all service activities
- Participate fully in all SCI AmeriCorps orientations, trainings, surveys and evaluations
- Complete a Social Capital Youth Project for host site partner youth enrichment programming

• Must be at least 18 years of age at time of enrollment
