Leaders for an Equitable Tomorrow (LET) is a program that supports youth mental health through resources, community events, and public workshops developed by teens, for teens.

In 2023-2024 the LET program hosted 3 educational workshops and 4 wellbeing activities that were attended by 110 youth and 220 total individuals.
